Mother Bachmann Maternity Center **215.245.4334**

At the Mother Bachmann Maternity Center in Bensalem, certified nurse-midwives, in consultation with obstetricians, provide complete prenatal care. Patients of the Mother Bachmann Maternity Center deliver their babies at St. Mary Medical Center in Langhorne.

In addition to prenatal care, Mother Bachmann provides in-hospital infant care and support services, such as nutrition and parenting classes.

St. Mary Children's Health Center **215.245.8873**

The St. Mary Children's Health Center provides primary medical care for newborns, children, and adolescents up to age 18. The services include routine well-child and sick visits, vaccinations, laboratory tests, hearing and vision screenings, specialist referrals, and social service referrals.

St. Mary Family Resource Center **215.245.8563**

The St. Mary Family Resource Center offers many services including housing assistance, job preparation and placement, family and substance abuse counseling, referrals to social services, English-as-a-second-language (ESL) classes, General Equivalency Diploma (GED) tutoring, and much more.

BCHIP Adult Health Clinic **215.633.8652**

The Bucks County Health Improvement Partnership (BCHIP) Adult Health Clinic, located at St. Mary Community Ministries in Bensalem, serves uninsured, financially eligible Bucks County residents 18 years and older. Outpatient services include routine physical exams, diagnostic procedures, referrals to medical specialists and social service resources, and much more.

Financial Assistance

St. Mary Medical Center is pleased to inform our patients that we offer financial assistance programs. Medically necessary services will be provided without charge or at a reduced rate to eligible individuals who cannot afford to pay for all or part of their care at St. Mary.

Financial Assistance Programs

St. Mary Medical Center will assist you in applying for Medical Assistance or for the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) — the first step in the process. If you do not qualify for Medical Assistance or CHIP, you may be eligible to receive medical care at no charge or at a reduced rate through the St. Mary Financial Assistance Program. Our financial counselors also can assist you with the application for the St. Mary Financial Assistance Program.

To apply for financial assistance programs, you must make available certain detailed financial information concerning income, assets, and expenses.

Eligibility for the St. Mary Financial Assistance Program

To be eligible for free medical care through the St. Mary Financial Assistance Program, your family income must be at or below 250 percent of the federal poverty level.

To qualify for partial assistance, your family income must be below 400 percent of the federal poverty level.
